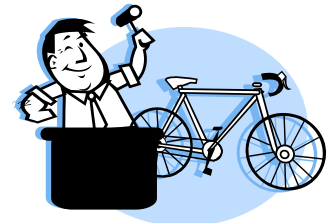

We have been discouraged to replace our current lighting system with an equivalent one because it does not meet the established electrical

codes. Also, we hope to find a more efficient means of lighting that might be more environmentally friendly. Thanks to Jessie Opel, we are looking into the possibility of using solar lights to mark our course. This year we will be experimenting with some prototypes of solar lighting to see if it will serve our needs. If you notice some solar lights set up on the

course, please let us know if you feel they can serve our needs. If they do not pan out we will pursue other options. To help the club with this endeavor we have set up a “**Keep It Lit**” fund. 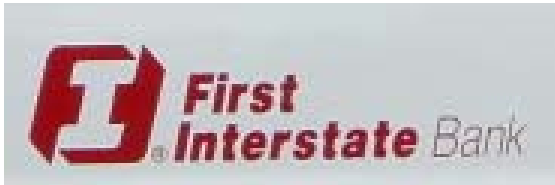
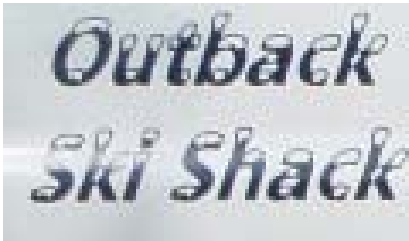

Financial Report

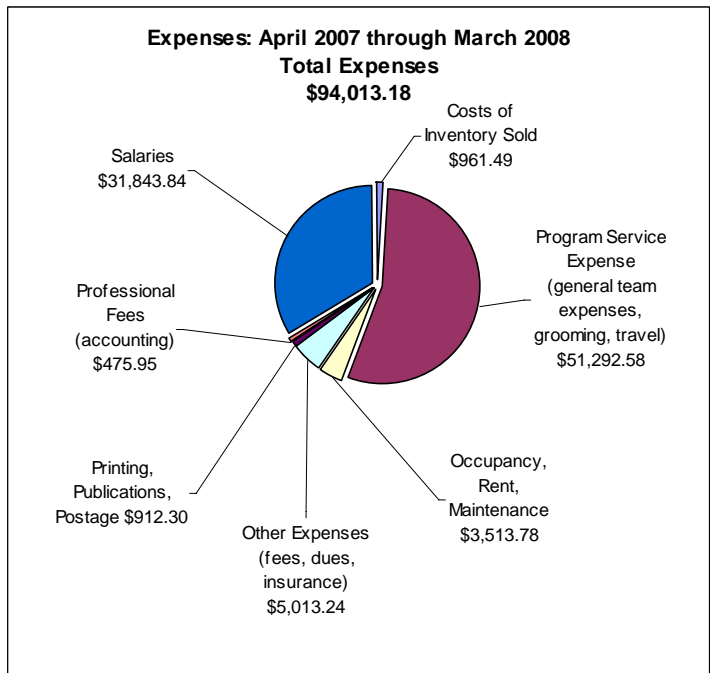
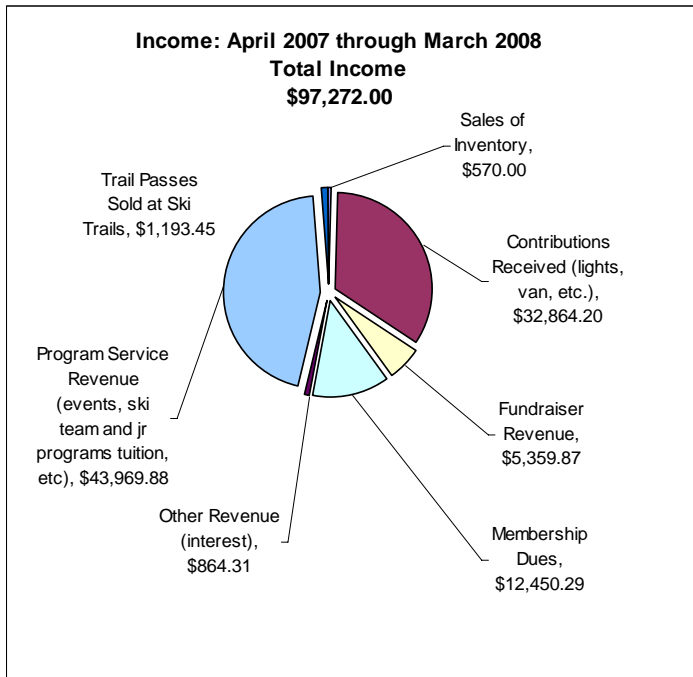
Fiscal Year: April 2007 through March 2008
